This matter having been fully considered, and proof being made to the satisfaction of the Court, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Judgment be entered for Plaintiff, the Department of Fair Employment and Housing.

It is further ordered that Defendant BODY CENTRAL, INC. take the following affirmative steps:

- 1. Comply with California law, including the Unruh Civil Rights Act, Civil Code § 51, with respect to the operation of single-sex health club facilities within the State of California. Body Central, Inc. shall make its health club at 545 Ross Street in Santa Rosa, California, open and welcoming to men, who will be granted the full privileges of membership.
- 2. Body Central, Inc. shall provide access to showers and locker room facilities to its male members.
- On or before December 31, 2006, Body Central, Inc. shall make permanent modifications to the Body Central facility at 545 Ross Street in Santa Rosa, California, to provide facilities where male health club members can have a shower after their workout.
- ħ. From the date of this order until December 31, 2006, Body Central, Inc. shall provide access to the shower for its male health club members on an as-needed basis.
- 3. Body Central, Inc. shall immediately cease and desist from using in its advertising or posting the phrases "Making Women Stronger" or "Fitness for Women." Body Central, Inc. shall also immediately cease and desist from using or referring to the internet address www.bodycentralwomen.com.
- 4. Body Central, Inc. shall appear at an Order to Show Cause hearing, in Department 18 of this court, located at 1450 Guerneville Road, Santa Rosa, CA 95403, on Dec. 14 2006; at \ \(\frac{7}{3} \omega \text{a.m./p.m.}, \text{ then and there to show cause, if any, why:}
 - Body Central, Inc. has not complied with this order;
- Ъ. Body Central, Inc. should not be fined, in the amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per day, payable to the Department, for each day that it continues to defy the terms of this order.

Dear Ms. Hartnett:

Because of your continued failure to comply with the Settlement Agreement, the Department has obtained an order against Body Central, enclosed with this letter. Body Central, Inc. has been ordered to appear in Department 18 of the Sonoma County Superior Court, 1450 Guerneville Road, Santa Rosa, at 8:30 a.m. on December 14, 2006, to explain to the court why Body Central, Inc. should not be fined \$50 per day for its failure to comply with the order. Specifically, Body Central has been ordered to make the following changes before that date:

- Make Body Central an open and welcoming place for men, with full privileges of membership for male members;
- Provide access to the showers for men, on an "as-needed" basis, immediately;
- Make permanent modifications to Body Central in order to provide a shower area for men, on or before December 31, 2006;
- Stop using the phrases "Making Women Stronger," "Fitness for Women," or making reference to the internet address.
