During a twenty eight (28) year career in Law Enforcement, I was assigned to virtually all of the most challenging and demanding assignments including nearly two decades in various investigative functions, including approximately nine (9) years in varying levels of narcotic enforcement including an assignment to LA IMPACT, a Los Angeles County regional narcotic task force tasked with conducting multi-state and international major narcotic and money laundering operations. The operations I participated in resulted in the seizure of approximately eight (8) tons of cocaine, twenty (20) tons of marijuana, and hundreds of pounds of heroin and methamphetamine as well as the seizure of over ten (10) million dollars in cash and assets. My assignments included approximately six (6) years as a Robbery-Homicide Detective that involved a number of high profile and death penalty cases, providing a superior level work product that has withstood Appellate and Supreme Court scrutiny. Additional assignments include Internal Affairs, Gangs, Surveillance, and Terrorism cases working conjunctively with various federal agencies including the FBI and the Joint Terrorism Task Force.
