My office, the U.S. Army Professional Responsibility Branch, Office of The Judge Advocate General, regulates the professional conduct of attorneys and paralegals in the Army Judge Advocate General's Corps and the Judge Advocate Legal Service. As such, The Judge Advocate General forwarded to me your letter, dated August 26, 2016, that you sent to her via email message alleging prosecutorial misconduct at Fort Campbell in the court-martial case of *United States v. Martin*. This letter acknowledges receipt of your letter, dated August 26, 2016, that you sent to The Judge Advocate General.

Because the court-martial case in question resulted in a conviction, it moves to a post-trial phase and potentially an appellate phase. Therefore, in accordance with Army Regulation 27-1, paragraph 7-3(b)(2), this office is deferring review of your allegations until the post-trial and appellate phases of the court-martial are complete. At that time, this office will resume its review of your allegations.
